


## **BUCKY**



Bucky is an ex Royal Navy diving Gemini often seen carried on the deck of the Royal Navy's Hunt Class and Sandown mine countermeasure vessels in a support role. Constructed out of Hypalon material, Bucky's versatility and durability is down to her design and manufacture. The vessel is easily launched and is ofted used as the goto vessel for hard to access areas where no slipway is available. With 2 x operators she still offers enough deck space for emergency situations. Owing to her small size she is often used for those hard to reach projects which could mean under a jetty or a shallow river.
